The new area at the 'triangle' on the approach to the dale is establishing itself well and several more plants have been added to the section alongside the playground shed.

Additional culinary herbs will be added to the herb garden in the picnic area for community use.

Don't forget to look out for hedgehogs – they have woken up and are visiting local gardens once again. They need fresh water and can eat hedgehog food or **meat-based** cat or dogfood but please NO bread and milk or mealworms (These can kill them)
