 - b) Bateman's Tomb

 - c) The Rear of Village Hall grant news awaited for greenhouse. Ex-school toilet block price to reroof received. The clerk has asked our County Councillor for a grant to cover or part pay for it and Council resolved to place an order for £3650 to be paid for

out of grant or reserves with GPN Specialist Leadworks. Additional cost for boarding up entrances until usage agreed to be agreed at the site meeting.

d) Village Hall Management Committee report –
The ceilidh had to be cancelled due to a clash with an event in Youlgrave Village
Hall that would have divided support. Harvest supper is the next event and a full
programme is planned for Christmas and 2024.

e) Climate and Nature Group

Air monitoring report finally received and circulated. Equipment provider is liaising with DDDC over details with results to be explained in Village newsletter. It was agreed that the Water Butt to catch the shed/toilet roof run off should be placed on the strip being reclaimed with agreement from Greencroft Farm. A child proof covered water butt was approved for purchase. More hedgehogs have been seen this year but sadly one has been run over.
